WHO ARE WE

Scottish WILPF is a local branch of WILPF UK.

WILPF was established in 1915 in the Hague at the International Congress of Women, and is the oldest women's international peace organisation active today with National Sections covering every continent.

Scotland's Chrystal Macmillan (13 June 1872 - 21 September 1937) was one of the founders of WILPF and played a leading role in organising the Congress.

As a feminist, peace activist and barrister, she campaigned all her life for women to have full citizenship rights.

Our mission is to end and prevent war: ensure that women are represented at all levels in peace-building processes: defend human rights; and promote social. economic and political justice.

WHAT WE DO

The modern Scottish WILPF branch was established in 2009.

We engage in grassroots activism on issues such as disarmament, antimilitarism, human rights, climate justice, equality, gender and peace.

We have connections with academic departments on Women, Peace and Security at the University of Edinburgh and the University of Strathclyde, as well as organisations such as Engender, Glasgow Women's Library and Soroptimist International.

We host regular meetings which take place face to face or virtually via Zoom and are open to all women.
